INTRODUCTION

The LNK-AI Analog Input Peripheral Device adds four channels of 4 - 20 mA or 0 - 10 volt analog inputs to a Modbus® network configured with an FCS Flexible Control System Controller.

The LNK-AI is designed to receive an analog signal from one to four transmitters and communicates back to the FSC using Modbus® RS-485. The FCS monitors the connection and will indicate a loss of communications.

Ideal for large applications to create an efficient distribution network of specialized gas detection devices with fewer wires running directly from the controller.

- » Standard Modbus® RS-485 RTU
- » Scaling and zoning capabilities supported by the FCS
- » Configurable default settings for any interruption in communication
- » Standard water / dust tight, corrosion resistant enclosure (drip proof)

The FCS Flexible Control System can accommodate up to a maximum of 60 analog inputs made up of different combinations of LNK-AI peripheral devices and internal -AI options. The maximum number of LNK-AI devices that can be attached to the FCS is fifteen. However, that maximum will change depending on whether one or two of the internal -Al options are installed.

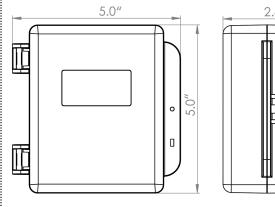

Standard Enclosure Dimensions



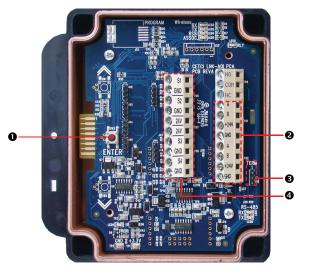

INSTALLATION

The LNK-AI should be installed on a flat vertical surface using the four 4.4 mm (0.175") diameter mounting holes provided to maintain water tight status.

Two 12.7 mm ($\frac{1}{2}$ in) conduit entry points are provided in the enclosure. Both are located in the enclosure base. One in the rear of the base and one on the bottom edge of the base. The clearance from the PCA to the base enclosure is 12.7 mm ($\frac{1}{2}$ in). Do not use a conduit connector that has more than 12.7 mm ($\frac{1}{2}$ in) of thread length.

NOTE: When mounting the enclosure, allow enough room to allow the end user to open the door fully to access the wiring terminal.

The LNK-Al is intended for indoor use and should be protected from extreme weather conditions. The LNK-Al requires no assembly and virtually no maintenance other than ensuring that excess water or dust is not somehow entering the enclosure and physically damaging the circuit board or internal components. There are no serviceable or replaceable elements or components in this device.

WIRING CONNECTIONS

All wiring should be run within properly grounded (earth or safety) conduit. Signal output and supply should be in shielded cable. The cable shield should be connected to earth ground at the controller/power supply that is providing power for the LNK-AI.

Wiring Power Connections

The LNK-AI is a low voltage powered device. Any application of operating voltages higher than indicated in the specification may result in damage.

Double check wiring connections prior to powering the transmitter. Damage from incorrect wiring connections or from too much voltage applied is not covered under warranty.

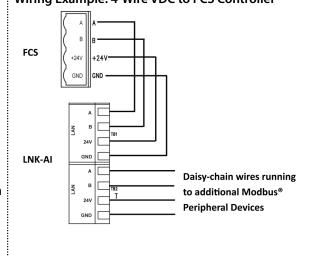
External power to the LNK-Al must be supplied by a 24 VDC power supply or a Class 2 (or better) transformer and connected to the Modbus wiring terminal. The wiring should be 4-conductor shielded 16 awg stranded within conduit in a network wiring (daisy-chain) configuration.

NOTE: WARRANTY VOID IF SOLID-CORE WIRE IS USED AT THE WIRING TERMINAL STRIP. When using solid core wiring for distribution (in the conduit), use stranded wire pigtails 18 AWG within the enclosure to connect

to the circuit board. The rigidity of solid-core wire can pull a soldered terminal strip completely off a circuit board and this will not be covered under warranty.
